# Mandatory

- 1. Photo ID or Government Issued ID for those 18+.

## **General Daily Attire:**

Comfortable walking shoes/sneakers. Dress for semi-cool weather and cool evenings. Coach busses tend to get chilly as well. Long sleeve t-shirt at night. Concert T-Shirt is for performances only.

#### **Suggestions**

- 1. Backpack to carry around change of clothes and all the day's necessities
- 2. No snacks for Hotel Room.
- 3. Sunglasses & Hat- MUST
- 4. Sunscreen- Sealed Bottle-wrapped in a ziplock bag
- 5. Extra Instrument Supplies (Oil, Reeds, Mutes, Etc.)
- 6. Sneakers (Flip-Flops are not recommended because of the tendency for an ankle injury.
- 7. Any medications that you may need throughout the trip must be carried your person. You will not have access to luggage during the day.
- 8. Any over the counter medications that you may need you must provide yourself- teachers cannot administer medications unless your Doctor has filled out the appropriate forms. \*Allergy Medication you should have with you at all times.
