Packing List

Mandatory

- 1. Photo ID or Government Issued ID for those 18+.
- 2. Insurance Card (copy is fine- copy must be of both sides)
- 3. Watch or cell phone at all times
- 4. Concert Attire
 - a. Ladies: Black Dress Pants, Black Shoes, Black Top.
 - b. Gentlemen- Solid Black Long Sleeve Shirt, Long Tie, Black Pants(Solid), Black Socks, and Black Dress Shoes. No Exceptions!
- 5. As of this writing, masks are required on all flights. Masks are required on all modes of transportation (monorail, our buses, and all modes of transportation). Therefore, students should adequately have enough supplies for the four days.

General Daily Attire:

Comfortable walking shoes/sneakers. Dress for warm weather and cool evenings. Long sleeve shirt at night.

Suggestions:

- 1. Knapsack to carry around change of clothes and all the day's necessities. Sometimes we get caught in the rain!
- 2. **Please limit your snacks.** Remember you are flying so keep the weight down- there is plenty of candy at Disney. (You do not need any EXTRA sugar) Also, any food in carry-on's will be taken by TSA.
- 3. Sunglasses & Hat- MUST
- 4. Sunscreen- Sealed Bottle-wrapped in a ziplock bag (must be checked) And, one or two small 3oz or smaller travel sunscreen for the first day. (sealed)
- 5. Extra Instrument Supplies(Oil, Reeds, Mutes, Etc.)
- 6. Sneakers!!
- 7. PONCHO- It rains sporadically and quickly in FL and then it stops! Or, you are forced to pay \$5-10 for one. We do not return to the hotel to change clothing. Be prepared.
- 8. Any medications that you may need throughout the trip must be carried on-DO NOT CHECK IT! You must have the proper med. forms completed.
- 9. Pack layers for comfort in all likely weather.
- 10. Concert Music (in luggage)
- 11. LIMIT your technology! Leave the devices at home. You'll be exhausted.

- 12. Snacks may get taken away at security during the airports. An empty water bottle (container) would be best. Plan on drinking a bottle of water in the park per hour.
- 13. A good idea to save space is to bring one full size set of shampoo/conditioner for your whole room, if you can agree on brands. (This MUST be checked)
- 14. PLEASE pack all items that can leak or spill in their own plastic bags. It is ideal to pack them upright and to bring a few extra zip lock bags.
- 15. Empty Garbage Bag for used clothes.
- 16. Do NOT bring expensive Jewelry.
- 17. Copy of itinerary at all times.
- 18. Souvenir and meal money. (Appx \$200 as per previous letter)
- 19. Disney Gift Cards can be purchased in many locations- you can use these all over Disney World if you are more comfortable with this. They do not work at airports

STUDENTS ARE ONLY PERMITTED TO HAVE ONE SUITCASE STUDENTS ARE ONLY PERMITTED TO HAVE ONE CARRY-ON IN ADDITION TO THEIR INSTRUMENT (FLUTES, CLARINETS, ALTO Saxes, Violins, Violas all get placed as a carry on) Cello's and Basses are rented. Any large instruments will be checked. Percussionists will be given gig bags to take as their carry on as necessary.
